

Super Save Propane

Tank Sizes

In situations where natural gas is not available, we provide propane as an alternative source of heating fuel. Most furnaces, hot water tanks and fireplaces can be adapted to utilize propane as opposed to natural gas. We provide a variety of different sized bulk propane tanks to supply fuel for these and other appliances. The size of the tank is based on the combined total of BTUs (British Thermal Units) the appliances put out. The following is a general overview of the various tanks that we can supply, as well as some of their more common uses.

80 Gallon Tank



- used for small homes
- up to 90,000 BTUs
- 4.6' tall x 2.6' diameter (approx)
- Will hold approximately 360 litres of propane

500 Gallon Tank



- Used for small to mid-size homes with multiple appliances, including furnaces and hot water tanks
- Up to 400,000 BTUs
- 12' long x 3' diameter (approx)
- Will hold approximately 1,500 litres of propane

1,000 Gallon Tank



- Used for larger homes
- Up to 750,000 BTUs
- 16' long x 3.8' diameter (approx)
- Will hold approximately 3,100 litres of propane
